Terms & Conditions of Membership

All members are expected to pay the full annual fee according to their membership category when this falls due on the 1st March each year. Pro-rata reduced membership fees are available **ONLY** to new members in their first year of membership if they join part way through the membership year.

Membership renewal fees are due on 1st March each year and, whilst the Club will send notification by email to the tennis membership as well as post notices on the boards at the Club, it is the responsibility of each individual member to ensure that their renewal fees are paid by the due date. Non-receipt of renewal notification from the Club will not be accepted as a valid reason for failure to pay renewal fees.

The Club will offer a reduction in annual fees to all members in the form of an early payment discount, the amount of which will be communicated to members prior to the annual renewal date. The early payment discount will **ONLY** apply to membership renewal fees paid within 1 calendar month of the due date, and any members not having paid their renewal fees by this date will forfeit the early payment discount and will be expected to pay the full renewal fee. Only under exceptional circumstances and by prior arrangement with the Tennis Committee will early payment discounts be applicable more than 1 month after renewal fees are due.

The Club will offer an additional discount of 10% to families, defined as any household where more than 1 occupant is member of the Club. The family discount will **ONLY** apply to memberships where the renewal fees are paid within 1 calendar month after the due date. Any members not having paid their renewal fees by this date will forfeit the family discount and will be expected to pay the full renewal fee. Only under exceptional circumstances and by prior arrangement with the Tennis Committee will family discounts be applicable more than 1 month after renewal fees are due.

The Club will send out information to members via email and will display information on the notice boards at the Club. The club will not normally send out any information (such as club notices, renewals information) by post unless requested to do so in writing to the membership secretary. Members will be kept up to date with the latest Club information by e-mail and, in addition, by posting of notices on the noticeboards. It is the responsibility of individual members to ensure that the contact information held on the club database is up to date at all times by notification to the membership secretary on membership@cbltsc.com.

The Club does not offer part year memberships, payment holidays or refunds of fees unless under exceptional circumstances and by prior arrangement with the Tennis Committee. This is because all members are expected to contribute to the year round maintenance and upkeep of the club regardless of how often and when they make use of the facilities.

Members that have not paid renewal fees within 3 calendar months of the due date will be deemed to have lapsed their membership and will not be entitled to make use of the Club facilities. Members wishing to rejoin the Club after lapsing their membership, whenever that may be, will be expected to pay a joining fee as per any other member joining the Club. Only under exceptional circumstances and by prior arrangement with the Tennis Committee will lapsed members be able to rejoin the Club without payment of a joining fee. A list of lapsed members will be displayed on Club notice boards to facilitate the monitoring of court use by the current members.

The Club requires all members to adhere to the Club Code of Conduct which has been developed by the Tennis Committee, and in addition specific Codes of Conduct for Parents/Guardians and Young People. Up to date copies of these Codes of Conduct are displayed on the Club notice boards and are available on the Club website. Any members failing to abide by their respective Code will be challenged as regards their conduct and may be asked to leave court or the Club premises. Continual refusal to abide by the Code may result in withdrawal of membership.

The Club has an agreed policy on court priority. An up to date copy of this policy is displayed on the Club notice boards and is available on the Club website. The Tennis Committee requires all members to abide by the priorities set out in the policy, and to act according to the standards set out in the policy when invoking priority over court use, or when being asked to vacate a court. Any members failing to act in accordance with this policy may be reported to the Tennis Committee. Continued failure to act in accordance with the policy may result in withdrawal of membership.

The Club allows members to bring visitors onto Club premises to use either the court or clubhouse facilities at a cost of £3.00 per day, paid on entry to the Club, and **ONLY** when signed in by the member in the visitors book. However, visitors will be strictly limited to a maximum of 3 visits per calendar year after which they would be expected to formally join the Club as either a playing or a social member.

The Club receives an allocation of tickets for the Wimbledon Championships each year and makes these tickets available to members through a public ballot. However, Club and LTA rules determine that the **ONLY** members eligible for entry into the ballot for tickets are:

- a. Those playing members that are aged 8 years and over at the time of the ballot (excludes members in the Junior U8 and Social membership categories)
- b. Those members that have fully paid their renewal fees by the published due date
- c. Those members that are also members of the LTA British Tennis Membership scheme

The Tennis Committee encourages all members to sign up for membership of British Tennis as, not only is the ballot restricted to these members, but in addition the Club allocation of Wimbledon tickets is determined by the number of members signed up to the scheme.
