“PLAYERS’ CODE”

This “Players’ Code” is intended as a reminder of some key principles relating to team tennis.

Commitment

- Where you have committed to play in certain matches, we would ask that you endeavour to keep those dates free.
- If you have committed and been selected to represent the Club in a particular match, but for some unexpected reason are unable to play in that match, please notify the relevant team captain well in advance of the match date so that he/she has sufficient time to find a replacement player.
- Other than in exceptional circumstances (eg. sudden illness or injury), don’t leave it until the day before or actual day of the match to tell the team captain that you are unavailable.

Match Days

Please make every effort:

- in the case of home matches, to be at the Club at least twenty minutes before the appointed start time; and
- in the case of away matches, to be at the opposing club’s ground at least ten minutes before the appointed start time.

Post-match refreshments

- Please allow time to stop for the post-match tea and (in the case of home matches) to assist with the washing up, etc.
- Where you haven’t provided food, don’t forget to offer a financial contribution to those that have and remember that any bar slate should be shared equally between all team members.
